



Children's Program Arrival & Excuse Policy
(All Children's Programming, day & night)

All children, age infant through 2nd grade must be escorted to their classroom by a parent or other responsible adult and delivered to the teacher or assistant teacher. No child should be left in a classroom without an adult present.

Additionally, all children, age infant through 2nd grade, will not be released to anyone other than a parent at the conclusion of each program. If other arrangements are necessary, written permission signed by a parent must be given to the child's teacher. Older siblings cannot be in charge of pick up or drop off for any child age infant through 2nd grade.

Parents/Guardians of children in 3rd through 6th grades: should you choose to meet your child(ren) somewhere other than the classroom after any program, it is important that your child(ren) be able to communicate that plan to his or her teacher. All meeting spots must be inside the building. Volunteer leaders will hold any child in class that does not have a plan for dismissal with their parent or guardian.

In consideration of our volunteer leaders, please be sure to collect your children promptly. This enables the volunteer leaders to gather their own children, and to attend to their own schedules for the day/evening. Children who are not picked up on time will be escorted to room 'Mary' for dismissal.
