1. All youth stay in groups of at least 3 people for safety and tell a counselor where you are going.
2. Please respect the privacy and property of others, including camp property. No purple dorms! (red [girls] + blue [boys] = purple)
3. Any injury or other problem should be reported immediately to one of the camp staff.
4. Leave food in the dining hall! Please do not bring into dorm rooms and they bring bugs.
5. The point of Henlopen is to spend time with God and friends. Do not bring iPod, etc. to listen to by yourself. Also, do not use cell phones throughout the day. There will be predefined times you can call your parents if they desire.
6. Drinking alcoholic beverages, taking illegal drugs or smoking of any kind (including cigarettes) are strictly prohibited. We'll turn the stuff over to the State Police, call your parents...it's just a sticky situation you should avoid altogether.
7. Matches, lighters, knives and other weapons of any kind are strictly prohibited.
8. Please leave the camp in the same or better condition than when you arrived - don't trash the place!
9. When we go to Rehoboth, you may **not**: go to Hooters, obtain piercings or tattoos (henna or otherwise), or buy laser pointers, stink bombs or itching powder, etc.
